FAQ: Microneedling

Who is SkinPen?

SkinPen is the first FDA-cleared microneedling device, designed to safely and effectively stimulate skin remodeling by creating thousands of controlled micro-injuries. It's clinically proven and trusted worldwide.

What is microneedling?

Microneedling is a minimally invasive treatment that uses fine needles to create tiny punctures in the skin. This process triggers your body's natural healing response, producing more collagen and elastin for smoother, firmer, and younger-looking skin.

What skin concerns does microneedling help with?

Microneedling can improve:

- Fine lines and wrinkles
- Acne scars and other scarring
- Uneven skin texture
- Enlarged pores
- Skin laxity
- Hyperpigmentation and sun damage

How many treatments will I need?

Many clients see noticeable improvement after just one session, but for optimal results we recommend a series of 3-6 treatments, spaced about 4-6 weeks apart.

Is there downtime?

Microneedling has minimal downtime. You may experience redness, sensitivity, and mild swelling for 1-3 days after treatment. Some light flaking or dryness may also occur as your skin heals.

Is microneedling safe?

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Yes - SkinPen is FDA-cleared and safe for most skin types when performed by a trained professional. We'll review your medical history and skin condition before your treatment to ensure it's appropriate for you.

Does microneedling hurt?

We apply a topical numbing cream before treatment to minimize discomfort. Most clients report the procedure feels like light pressure or a mild scratching sensation.

Can I wear makeup afterward?

We recommend avoiding makeup and skincare products for at least 24 hours post-treatment to allow your skin to heal properly.

How important is aftercare?

Aftercare is crucial for the best results and to protect your skin as it heals. Use only the recommended gentle cleansers, moisturizers, and sunscreens, and avoid active ingredients, exfoliants, or heavy makeup for a few days.
